

# Affordable IVF



The NSW Government is investing **\$80 million** over four years to:

Extend the rebate to assist with costs of pre-IVF fertility testing.



Expand the availability of lower cost IVF treatment at government supported IVF clinics.



Introduce a rebate of up to \$2000 for women who are using private fertility clinics to undergo IVF and other assisted reproductive technology (ART) treatment



Extend the statewide fertility preservation service for patients with a medical need



These initiatives will support families with the high costs associated with pre-IVF fertility testing, fertility treatments and preservation.

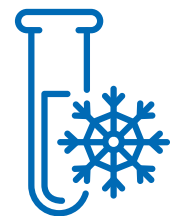
## Lower Cost IVF Treatment
