

Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966 – Section 9 Licence to supply by wholesale poisons

- 1. This licence is issued to registered pharmacists in a registered pharmacy.
- 2. This licence authorises the supply by wholesale of substances in Schedule 1.
- 3. This licence is subject to the conditions in Schedule 2.
- 4. This licence remains in force until 1 February 2026 unless earlier cancelled by the Secretary, NSW Health and is not transferrable.

Schedule 1 – Substances for supply by wholesale

- The Schedule 3 Poison naloxone for the treatment of opioid overdose
 - Naloxone 1.8 mg nasal spray
 - Naloxone 1 mg/mL prefilled syringe

Schedule 2 — Schedule of conditions

- 1. The licensee must only supply a substance listed in Schedule 1 by wholesale to an authorised First Aider.
- 2. The licensee must only supply a substance listed in Schedule 1 on the written order signed by the authorised First Aider.
- 3. A substance listed in Schedule 1 must only be supplied in the original unopened packs as received from the supplier.
- 4. The licensee must make, and hold for a period of at least 2 years, a record of the supply of a substance in Schedule 1.
