

Postgraduate Nursing and Midwifery Scholarships

Proof of employment for applicants

NSW Health Nursing and Midwifery Office (NaMO) offer scholarships to individual registered nurses and midwives who are studying a postgraduate course. They are open to those working permanently in full- or part-time positions in NSW Health. Casual employees may also be eligible.

Nurses and midwives applying to Postgraduate Nursing and Midwifery Scholarships must provide proof of their current employment in NSW Health. This form is to verify an applicant's employment status within NSW Health.

Note: Applicants undertaking postgraduate study to gain registration as a midwife must provide evidence that they are employed in a recognised midwifery student position in a public maternity service.
