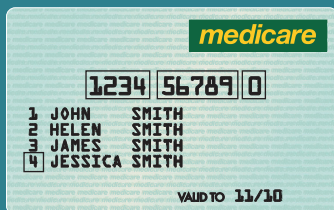


Public Dental Services

General and emergency dental care

Free for all children under 18 with a Medicare card



Free for adults with one of the following concession cards



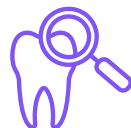
Brush your teeth morning and night

Contact your local public dental service. They will ask for your Medicare card details. If you are an adult, you will also need your concession card details.

Go to the closest hospital emergency department if you have:

- Swelling in your face or neck

- A serious injury to your face
