Approval to Administer Restricted Substances and Drugs of Addiction

Persons to which this Approval applies 1

Staff at:

- 1. Hospitals operated by public health organisations within the meaning of the Health Services Act 1997
- 2. Correctional centres where health services are provided by Justice Health and Forensic Mental Health Network
- 3. Other correctional centres (see condition 2 below)

Manner of direction 2

A direction by an authorised practitioner made in:

- An electronic patient records system, or
- A paper based patient record

A direction by an authorised practitioner includes reviewing, and signing a notation made in a record by another person at the hospital.

3 Conditions

- 1. The direction is in accordance with the Partnered Pharmacist Medication Charting model of care issued by the NSW Ministry of Health.
- 2. This Approval only applies to other correctional centres where a Justice Health and Forensic Mental Health Network authorised practitioner made the direction in accordance with this Approval.

4 Validity

The Approval commences on the day it is signed and dated, and is valid unless cancelled or revoked by the Secretary, NSW Health.
