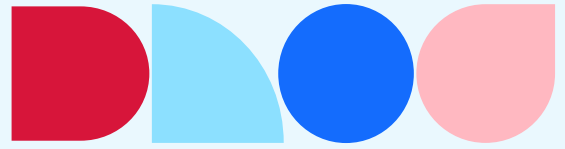

## Improving the safe use of monitored medicines



### What is SafeScript NSW?

SafeScript NSW is computer software that allows prescribers (general practitioners, other medical specialists and nurse practitioners) and pharmacists to access real-time information about a patient's prescription history for certain high-risk medicines, known as monitored medicines, such as opioids and benzodiazepines.

Access to this information helps prescribers and pharmacists to make safer clinical decisions about their patient's care.

1. [Register for SafeScript NSW](#) which takes less than 10 minutes to complete.



2. [Complete the accredited eLearning modules](#) which explain how and when to use the system, information about monitored medicines and clinical practice, and how to support patients who may be at risk of harm.
